The following notice is published pursuant to Section 95A(3) of the *Environment Protection* and *Biodiversity Conservation Act* 1999 (EPBC Act).

Lendlease Communities (Mt Gilead) Pty Limited is proposing to construct a residential development at Gilead, NSW. The overall development will be for residential land use and is planned to consist of residential dwellings, with an indicative yield of approximately 1,700 lots, associated infrastructure, community centre and small kiosk/store, parkland, open space and biodiversity offset and environmental conservation areas. The proposed action has been determined to be a "controlled action" under the EPBC Act and will therefore require assessment and approval by the Commonwealth Department of the Environment and Energy before it can proceed. The controlling provision under the EPBC Act is "Listed threatened species and communities" (Sections 18 and 18A) and the assessment approach is through preliminary documentation.
